We invite you to join us for Food Truck Throw Down event on Friday, August 16, 2024 at Pepper Town Market in Bonifay, FL. This event will feature a competition among food truck vendors.

Each vendor choosing to enter into this competition will be asked to provide at least one (1) food option that would cost the customer \$3-\$5. As a part of this competition the customers get to vote for their favorite food truck based on their food purchase.

Customers are given a ticket with each food purchase and a bucket is assigned to each participating food truck vendor. Customers will "vote" by placing their tickets in the bucket of their favorite food truck vendor. The food truck with the most votes will receive a trophy award and the choice of either \$100 cash prize OR a free registration in the 2025 Down Home Street Festival sponsored by the Holmes County Chamber of Commerce. The winning food truck will also be awarded a free registration at an upcoming Food Truck Friday event sponsored by Pepper Town Market.

Additional tickets for voting may be purchased for \$1 each, with proceeds going to a local charity or non-profit organization.

To create a more profitable market for vendors, we are making an effort to limit this event to SIX FOOD TRUCKS.
